Format:

Cadaveric hands-on training, device-based skill stations, crisis airway simulation, checklist-based OSCE, gamified team scoring.

Workshop Description:

Airway management in Emergency Medicine demands more than technical intubation skill. It requires preparation, oxygenation strategy, first-pass discipline, rescue planning, team communication, and the ability to recognize failure early. This six-hour cadaveric and crisis airway masterclass will provide delegates with an immersive, hands-on airway learning experience using cadaveric anatomy, direct and video laryngoscopy, bougie-assisted intubation, supraglottic rescue, flexible scope exposure, and failed-airway decision-making. The workshop will use a structured airway checklist and gamified OSCE scoring to ensure that delegates do not merely observe procedures but demonstrate airway readiness under guided faculty supervision.

Learning Objectives:

By the end of the workshop, delegates should be able to:

1. Identify relevant upper airway and front-of-neck anatomy on cadaveric specimens.
2. Perform structured preparation for emergency airway management using a checklist.
3. Demonstrate direct and video laryngoscopy technique with appropriate tube delivery.
4. Use bougie, supraglottic devices, and BVM strategies for rescue oxygenation.
5. Recognize failed airway progression and verbalize backup airway plans.
6. Demonstrate post-intubation confirmation, tube security, sedation planning, and ventilation readiness.
